RESOLUTION 4737
UITICE STIPULATION

WHEREAS: The Puerto Rico Electric Power Authority (PREPA) is a public corporation and an instrumentality of the Government of Puerto Rico created by Act No. 83 of May 2, 1941, as amended (Act No. 83). PREPA was created to provide electrical energy in a reliable way, contributing to the general welfare and sustainable future of the people of Puerto Rico, maximizing benefits and minimizing social, environmental and economic impacts. In addition, it provides a service based on affordable, fair, reasonable and non-discriminatory cost that is consistent with environmental protection, non-profit, focused on citizen participation and its clients.

WHEREAS: Act No. 83 authorizes PREPA, pursuant to its purposes, to grant contracts and formalize all the instruments that are necessary or convenient in the exercise of any of its powers.

WHEREAS: The *Unión Insular de Trabajadores Industriales y Construcciones Eléctricas, Inc.* (UITICE) has expressed that its members are willing to perform additional functions as required by PREPA, and, to negotiate a new salary scale for Line Technicians.

WHEREAS: As such, PREPA and UITICE desire to enter into a Stipulation that establishes the terms and conditions under which this modification will take place.

WHEREAS: The negotiated terms make it possible to provide services, whilst purporting efficiency in the corporation's operations, while in harmony with PREPA's fiscal situation.

THEREFORE: In accordance with Act No. 83, PREPA's Governing Board resolves to:

Authorize the Chief Executive Officer to sign the Stipulation with UITICE, on behalf of the Puerto Rico Electric Power Authority.
